Plan provides for bifurcated treatment of the same claim in paragraph 8A. Trustee objects to confirmation of a plan that proposes to have Debtor make direct payments on the ongoing payment and Trustee to make payments on the pre-petition arrears. Lastly, the Plan fails to properly provide for the claim of Fay Servicing (Arrears per POC: \$232,463.08, Plan \$208,901.54. Ongoing payments per POC \$2,117.86; Plan: \$3,481.69). Objection to Confirmation #32 filed 2/9/2026 by Fay Servicing.
