CHAPTER 13 WEBSITES

The Chapter 13 Trustee is required, by law, to provide information about bankruptcy cases under his administration to parties (debtors, debtors' attorneys, creditors and creditors' attorneys) that have legal interests in Chapter 13 cases in the Western District of Missouri.

Listed below are the addresses for two Chapter 13 websites made available to the bankruptcy community by the Trustee. A description of each website, a summary of information provided at each site, and information as to who can access each website is provided.

13Network is accessible to debtors, debtors' attorneys, creditors and creditors' attorneys. For specific information about Chapter 13 cases in the Western District of Missouri, scroll down to Missouri and Richard V. Fink, Trustee, and click on his name. Trustee Fink's home page will be displayed. The Trustee's home page provides information about office hours, local mailing address, telephone number, fax number, and the Chapter 13 plan payment address for the Western District of Missouri.

In addition, the Trustee's homepage also includes: the "Latest News" and printable Chapter 13 informational handouts.

Creditors, creditors' attorneys, or debtors' attorneys, who are legal parties in interest in a Chapter 13 case in the Western District of Missouri, may gain access to the Trustee's database from this website. In order to gain access, the creditors or attorneys must submit an original, signed Web Access Agreement, via regular mail, to the Trustee's office. A blank Web Access Agreement may be printed off from this homepage. Once the Trustee's office has established access, creditors or attorneys may reach the Trustee's case database by clicking on "Chapter 13 Inquiry" – a hyperlink on the homepage. Simple instructions will lead to the case being sought.

A Chapter 13 debtor may **<u>not</u>** access information about his/her case from <u>www.13network.com</u>, but a debtor can click on the <u>http://www.ndc.org</u>, a hyperlink on the Trustee's homepage, to reach the website where information about his/her case may be reviewed.

A Chapter 13 debtor may log directly onto the <u>www.ndc.org</u> website to review specific, detailed information about his/her case, including creditors filing claims in his/her case, plan payments received, creditors paid, etc. This is the only website through which debtors may gain access to case information. See the "Chapter 13 Debtor Website" handout for specific instructions. Some national and regional creditors may also have access to information regarding Chapter 13 cases at this website.
