FILING A PROOF OF CLAIM

In almost all instances, it is necessary to file a Proof of Claim with the Bankruptcy Court in order to share in disbursements under the debtor's plan. Claim forms (Official Form 410) are available on the Court's website at http://www.uscourts.gov/sites/default/files/form_b_410_16.pdf. The Trustee will receive an electronic copy of your Proof of Claim on the business day after it has been filed with the Court.

DISBURSEMENT DATES

Effective February 1, 2018, disbursement checks will be mailed on the first business day of the month.

ADDRESS CHANGES

All address changes must be filed with the Bankruptcy Court. The Trustee will receive an electronic copy of the address change on the business day following the filing date. Please be sure to reference the debtor's name, bankruptcy case number and your account number so we can determine which claim to change.

OFFICE HOURS
